APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO DISCONTINUE SERVICE

Adelphia Business Solutions, Inc. ("ABS"), the parent corporation of the following operating subsidiaries: Adelphia Business Solutions Operations, Inc. ("ABSO"), Adelphia Business Solutions of Kentucky, Inc. ("ABS of Kentucky"), Adelphia Business Solutions Investment, LLC ("ABS Investment"), and Adelphia Business Solutions of Virginia, LLC. ("ABS of Virginia"), (collectively, "ABS Subsidiary Companies"), hereby requests that the Federal Communications Commission (the "Commission") grant authority to the ABS Subsidiary Companies to discontinue certain of their facilities-based and resale telecommunications services, as specified herein, pursuant to § 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, (hereinafter, "Section 63.71"), and 47 U.S.C. § 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"). All services subject to this notice are either circuits provided over ABS' fiber, provided over unbundled network elements purchased from the applicable incumbent local exchange carrier or provided on a resale basis to business customers. The ABS Subsidiary Companies find that due to deteriorating market economic conditions and in an effort to restructure their debts under Chapter 11 protection, they are unable to continue providing these services. Accordingly, the ABS Subsidiary Companies request that

the Commission promptly issue its public notice of this Application so that service may be discontinued, at the earliest, by August 8, 2002.

I. Information Pursuant to Section 63.71

Pursuant to Section 63.71, the ABS Subsidiary Companies offer the following information:

B. Date of planned service discontinuance:

The ABS Subsidiary Companies plan to discontinue service to customers in August 2002. The dates on which the customers have been notified as to the “no earlier date” of discontinuance vary by the affected market. Exhibits A-1 and A-2, attached hereto and incorporated by reference, set forth the date on or about which approval to discontinue service is sought as well as the date that the notices to the customer were mailed.¹

¹ Regardless of the “no earlier” dates listed on the customer notices, ABS Subsidiary Companies will not discontinue any services until the FCC has approved this application.

C. Points of geographic areas of service affected

ABSO, a Delaware Corporation, is certificated to provide, and currently provides, local and long distance voice and data telecommunications services through resale and through its own facilities in, among others, the States of Arizona, Delaware, Illinois, Indiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Tennessee, Texas, and Washington, and the District of Columbia.

ABS Investment, a Delaware limited liability company, is certificated to provide, and currently provides, local and long distance voice and data telecommunications services through resale and through its own facilities in, among others, the States of Florida, New Jersey and New York.

ABS of Kentucky, a Delaware corporation, is certificated to provide, and currently provides, local and long distance voice and data telecommunications services through resale and through its own facilities in, among others, the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

ABS of Virginia, a Virginia limited liability company, is certificated to provide, and currently provides, local and long distance voice and data telecommunications services through resale and through its own facilities in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The ABS Subsidiary Companies provide service through their own facilities and through resale of the telecommunications services of the ILEC ("Total Service Resale") in the service territories affected by this discontinuance. The ABS Subsidiary Companies have made a decision to discontinue service to those customers in the metropolitan areas listed on Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, that are currently served via Total Service Resale, except under limited circumstances.

Specifically, the ABS Subsidiary Companies are discontinuing service to those resale customers that are not located in rates centers in which the ABS Subsidiary Companies are able to provide service through their own facilities. Additionally, the ABS Subsidiary Companies are discontinuing services to those customers that they serve through their own facilities in a limited number of metropolitan markets listed on Exhibit C listed herein.² The ABS Subsidiary Companies facilities-based customers in the States of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Missouri, Mississippi, New Jersey, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Vermont, and in the markets of Syracuse/Utica/Rome, New York; Norfolk, Virginia; and, Houston, Texas are **not** affected by this service discontinuance.

D. Brief description of the type of service affected

All of the ABS Subsidiary Companies' Total Service Resale customers not located in rate centers from which the ABS Subsidiary Companies can provide facilities-based service are being discontinued, including any interexchange services that the ABS Subsidiary Company may provide. In addition, the ABS Subsidiary Companies are discontinuing facilities-based services in markets, including any interexchange services that the ABS Subsidiary Company may provide, that are not currently free cash flow positive nor are projected to be free cash flow positive by the end of the third quarter 2002.

² ABSO had planned to initiate service in Cincinnati, Ohio, and has a significant amount of network in place for deployment of the service. This market will be a "closed" market. No commercial service was launched, and there are no customers affected by the market closing. ABSO does not believe that it must seek of approval of this market closing, but in an abundance of caution discloses this information and asks that, if the Commission believes that approval under Section 214 of the Act or Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules is required, that it be included as part of this Application.

E. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers

Exhibits A-1 and A-2, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, sets forth the dates on which the ABS Subsidiary Companies provided written customer notice in accordance with the requirements of Section 63.71, in the form of a letter sent by e-mail and U.S. Mail, addressed to customers. The form of each customer notice letter for each affected metropolitan area and/or type of service affected are attached as Exhibits B through W.

F. Non-dominance of the carrier with respect to the service being discontinued

The ABS Subsidiary Companies are non-dominant with respect to all of the telecommunications services that they propose to discontinue.

G. Service

In accordance with Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, the ABS Subsidiary Companies are mailing a copy of this application to the Governor and state utility commission of the States of Arizona, Delaware, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Maryland, Massachusetts, North Carolina, New York, Ohio, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, Washington, and the mayor of the District of Columbia, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense.

II. Circumstances of Discontinuance


On March 27, 2002, ABS, ABSO, ABS of Kentucky and four other Adelpia Business Solutions, Inc. subsidiaries not party to this Application, each commenced a case under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101, *et seq.*, by filing a voluntary petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York. On June 18, 2002, ABS Investment, ABS of Virginia and eight other ABS subsidiaries not party to this Application, each commenced a case under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101, *et seq.*, by filing a voluntary petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York. The discontinuance will permit ABS and the ABS Subsidiary Companies to reduce the cash outflow associated with (1) constructing or purchasing additional network elements within the markets to serve the affected customer and provisioning resale services to the affected customer base and (2) to reduce certain overhead costs associated with managing this customer base and operating field office in the closed markets. As a result, the ABS Subsidiary Companies will be able to focus on the provision of facilities-based services to customers that are located inside the Adelpia Business Solutions, Inc. operating companies' more mature facilities-based footprint that are, or projected to be, free cash flow positive by the end of the third quarter 2002 and require less capital expenditures to acquire and serve the established facilities-based customer base.

Accordingly, the discontinuance described herein is a part of ABS's reorganization initiatives in connection with its and certain of its subsidiaries' pending bankruptcy cases and should increase the likelihood that ABS and its subsidiaries could successfully emerge from Chapter 11.

III. Conclusion

The ABS Subsidiary Companies believe that the proposed discontinuance is reasonable and necessary. For the foregoing reasons, the ABS Subsidiary Companies respectfully request, pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, that the Commission promptly issue a Public Notice of this Application, approve the ABS Subsidiary Companies' discontinuance of all telecommunications services, offered on a resale or facilities-based basis, as described in this Application.


