MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO SUBMIT POST-WORKSHOP COMMENTS

AT&T Communications of the Southern Sates, LLC ("AT&T"), MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (collectively "WorldCom") and Covad Communications Company ("Covad") respectfully request an extension of time of two additional days to file post-workshop comments.

On July 12, 2002, the Florida Public Service Commission conducted its workshop related to KPMG Consulting, Inc.'s June 21, 2002, Draft Final Report of its Florida third-party Operational Support Systems ("OSS") testing. The Commission's current order requires the parties to submit post-workshop comments by Monday, July 22, 2002. Parties hereby request an additional two days in which to submit its comments. Transcripts of the July 12 workshop will

not be available until July 18 or 19, 2002 at the earliest. Extending the due date for the post-workshop comments until July 24, 2002 will permit the parties adequate opportunity to review the transcript prior to the submission of the post-workshop comments and will allow for more adequate and complete briefing of the issues raised during the workshop. BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. does not object to this additional time so long as these two days do not delay Staff's recommendation.

Accordingly, AT&T, WorldCom, and Covad request that the Commission grant its request for an additional two days to allow the parties adequate time to review the transcript of the July 12, 2002 proceedings.
