Enclosed please find Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P.'s ("Time Warner Telecom") response to the above-referenced data request.

Pursuant to §364.183(1), F.S., and Rule 22.006(5), F.A.C., Time Warner Telecom requests confidential treatment of Attachment A, Attachment C, Attachment D, and our response to questions 6(h), 7, 9(b), 14, 20, and 21. This information is considered proprietary confidential business information, as that term is defined in §364.183(3), F.S., thus exempt from §119.07(1) and §24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. The information is a trade secret and relates to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of Time Warner Telecom. Additionally, the information is intended to be private, and has not been otherwise disclosed by Time Warner Telecom.
