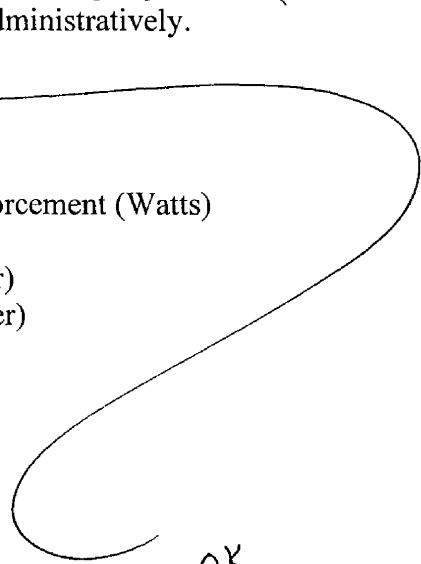

**RE:** Docket No. 010488-TI - Investigation and determination of method to credit flow-through reductions by eMeritus Communications, Inc. as required by Section 364.163, F.S.

By Order No. PSC-02-0624-CO-TI, issued May 6, 2002, consummating Order No. PSC-02-0478-PAA-TI, the Commission ordered eMeritus Communications, Inc. to issue a one-time refund to the business customers identified by the company who have been its customers since 1998 during June 2002 for failure to flow-through access charge reductions to its customers, remit any portion not refundable to the Commission for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund, and submit a final report in accordance with Rule 25-4.114, Florida Administrative Code. eMeritus Communications, Inc. submitted its final refund report to the Commission on July 31, 2002. The report stated that all monies were refunded to its current customers and, consequently, there were not any unrefundable monies. Therefore, the Proceedings against eMeritus Communications, Inc. are complete and this docket should be closed administratively.
