NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

The Citizens of the State of Florida, through their attorney, the Public Counsel, pursuant to Section 350.0611, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, hereby give notice of intervention in the above-referenced docket. The Citizens submit:

- 1. The docket number is 020413-SU and the name of the agency is the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 2. The Intervenor is the Office of Public Counsel, 111 West Madison Street, Room 812, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1400, and is entitled to participate as a matter of statutory right under Section 350.0611(1), which authorizes the Public Counsel "to appear in the name of the state or its citizens, in any proceeding or action before the commission..."

- 3. The Citizens will identify disputed issues of material fact at the proper point in the procedure of this case. At this point, however, the Citizens are not aware of what material facts will be disputed.
 - 4. As ultimate facts, the Citizens allege:
 - (a) Through Order No. PSC-01-0326-FOF-SU, the Commission ordered Aloha Utilities, Inc. ("Aloha") to increase its wastewater service availability charge for its Seven Springs system.
 - (b) Aloha failed to file a tariff in compliance with the PSC order and failed to collect the increased service availability charge ordered by the Commission.
 - (c) As a result Aloha's failure to comply with a lawful Commission order, the utility's CIAC is deficient.
 - (d) Unless adjusted, a deficiency in CIAC will result in a higher rate base and in future rates that are higher than if the utility had complied with Commission order.
 - (f) Aloha's customers should not be charged future rates that are higher because of Aloha's negligence and failure to collect the lawful service availability charge.

5. As relief, at this point in the proceedings, the OPC seeks the opportunity to present customer input for the Commission's consideration.
