Dear Mr. Kantor:

On May 28, 2002, I wrote you and explained that the 2001 Regulatory Assessment Fee, plus penalty and interest charges, had not been received and that in order to avoid a docket being established, the Commission must receive payment by June 18, 2002. The letter included a copy of the 2001 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form and a copy of Rule 25-24.514, Florida Administrative Code, which explains how to request cancellation of certificates. Payment was not received, therefore, Docket No. 020765-TC was established on July 19, 2002.

On July 22nd, the Commission received the company's 2001 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form showing zero revenues with the hand-written note "Out of the payphone business since 1999." In 1999, we have record showing that you proposed a \$100 settlement to keep the certificate active to resolve Docket No. 981154-TC, which had been established for the same rule violation. However, I have researched our records and cannot find record of any request for cancellation.

If you would like to cancel your payphone certificate in Florida, you must comply with Rule 25-24.514, Florida Administrative Code. A copy of that rule is enclosed. Please review this information and respond in writing by August 21, 2002. In the meantime, if you have any questions, just let me know. 25-24.514 Cancellation of a Certificate.

- (1) The Commission may cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:
- (a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;
 - (b) Violation of Commission rules or orders;
 - (c) Violation of Florida Statutes; or,
 - (d) Failure to provide service for a period of six (6) months.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request.

- (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee. ⁷
- (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled. ⁷

(3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
