

Dear Rosanne Gervasi:

I received your correspondence of August 16, 2002 and was surprised to hear that my client was alleging demanding compensation to stay connected to his sewer lines. Mr. Holzberg denies that accusation and knows that he can not request monies without the P.S.C.'s approval but stands firm in his right to disconnect the service if he so chooses. His position is that he has never been under the jurisdiction of the P.S.C. and Mr. Kyle has trespassed into his sewer lines. We have offered not to disconnect if Bonita Springs Utilities or Lee County will stop issuing permits until this matter can be resolved, to date I have not had a response.
