RE: Docket No. 020934-TL, BellSouth Telecommunications Inc. (BellSouth) Petition for Expedited Review of a Growth Code Denial by NANPA for Orlando (Magnolia)

On August 29, 2002, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code in the Magnolia switch (ORLDFLMADS1) located in the Orlando rate center.

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a specific customer in need of immediate numbering resources;
2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to the potential customer because of NANPA's denial of numbering resources; and
3) The potential customer cannot obtain service from the provider of its choice because the carrier does not have numbers available to fulfill the customer's needs.

Since the three required criteria of Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (September 20, 2002) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order.
