Pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") regulations, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, we are writing to notify you that Telecommunications Cooperative Network, Inc. ("TCN") has filed a Section 63.71 Application with the FCC for authorization pursuant to section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47. C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue, effective on or about October 3, 2002, its offering of intrastate and interstate long distance resold services in your state, and nationwide, to customers who have presubscribed to TCN or its underlying carrier. Pursuant to Section 63.71, we are also providing you with a copy of the Section 63.71 Application filed by TCN with the FCC.

TCN customers are being notified that TCN will cease providing long-distance service on or about October 3, 2002, and that they will have no further obligation except to pay for services received prior to termination. TCN customers are also being notified that in order to avoid interruption of their service, it will be necessary for them to find another service provider prior to on or about October 3, 2002. TCN has arranged for MCI Worldcom to take over customers' existing service if they so chose, and will provide customers with a letter of authorization ("LOA") and other forms necessary to effectuate that carrier selection. Customers may also 1-Isuselect a different long-distance carrier, and are advised that they should do so at their earliest convenience, but prior to October 3. 2002. In the meantime, should TCN customers have any urgent issues or questions pertaining to their current TCN service, they may call TCN's Customer Service Telephone Number (1.800.669.4826) for assistance.

Telecommunications Cooperative Network, Inc. ("TCN"), hereby seeks authorization pursuant to section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47. C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue, effective on or about October 3, 2002, its offering of intrastate and interstate long distance resold services in the United States to customers who have presubscribed to TCN or its underlying carrier.

Currently, TCN provides intrastate and interstate long distance services to less than one thousand (1000) business and individual customers who are presubscribed to TCN or its underlying carrier in approximately 35 states, utilizing the facilities of the underlying incumbent local exchange carrier in each of the relevant regions. TCN also provides switchless interstate long distance incident to other telecommunication services provided to customers who are not presubscribed to TCN or its underlying carrier. Through this application TCN seeks to discontinue services only to its presubscribed intrastate and interstate long distance customers. TCN is a non-dominant carrier with respect to the services to be discontinued.

TCN requests authority to withdraw from the long distance resale markets it currently services nationwide. The high cost of purchasing incumbent services for resale relative to the

competitive rates TCN must offer in the marketplace, along with the very limited base of customers TCN has been able to attract, require TCN to discontinue this service. Other substitute services are available from other competitive long distance carriers, and/or, where they possess authority to provide such service, the underlying incumbent local exchange carriers in the relevant regions. Thus, the public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of this services by TCN in these states.

Concident with the filing of this application. TCN customers are being sent a letter of notification of intent to discontinue service. (A copy of the text of the Letter of notification of intent to discontinue service is attached hereto). TCN does not intend to sell its customer list to any particular local service provider, but rather will allow its customers to select a new service provider of their own preference. However, customers are being provided appropriate paperwork from the underlying carrier should they wish to voluntarily complete it and remain on their current network. TCN will also provide customers with a toll-free customer assistance number for purposes of addressing any questions or concerns that may arise during the discontinuance of service transition period.

Simultaneous with this filing, as required pursuant to 47. C.F.R. § 63.71, letter of notification of intent to discontinue service and a copy of this application is being submitted to the Secretary of Defense, and to the Public Utility Commission and Governor of each state in which the discontinuance is to be effected.
