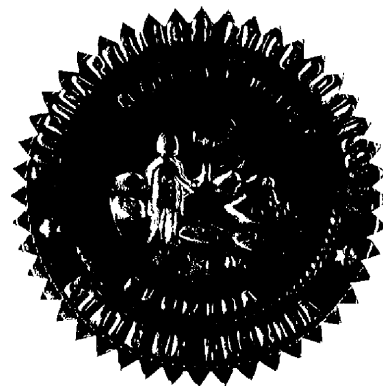

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## P R O C E E D I N G S

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2 CHAIRMAN JABER: Let's go ahead and get started with  
3 agenda.

4 Commissioners, there is an emergency item I would  
5 like to have staff address first, Docket Number 020948. Staff.

6 MS. PRUITT: Commissioners, Item 2 is staff's  
7 recommendation on Sprint Florida's emergency petition for  
8 waiver of the carrier selection requirements and disconnection  
9 of service rules. I understand Sprint would like to make a few  
10 comments.

11 - CHAIRMAN JABER: Mr. Rehwinkel.

12 MR. REHWINKEL: Thank you, Commissioners. Charles  
13 Rehwinkel and Susan Masterton on behalf of Sprint.

14 Commissioners, we fully concur in the staff's  
15 recommendation. And, furthermore, we appreciate both the  
16 Commission and the staff taking the time to allow this to come  
17 on as an emergency item. I really appreciate staff working  
18 with us.

19 There is one additional matter that we thought we  
20 would not have to broach with the Commission because we thought  
21 by now we would have it sorted out, and we may still get it  
22 worked out. But in an abundance of caution, since this is the  
23 last time we will be able to be before the Commission before  
24 the service termination date that Adelphia has indicated, is if  
25 the Commission could direct Adelphia to provide the name,

1 address, list of the customers who have not made a choice of an  
2 alternate provider. Otherwise, we won't be able to send the  
3 notices to the customers of this action.

4 CHAIRMAN JABER: Commission Staff, we have done that  
5 before?

6 MS. PRUITT: Yes, we have, Commissioners, in the  
7 Verizon case. On Page 3 of staff's recommendation in the third  
8 paragraph we mention an order in which we did order a LEC to  
9 provide the information to the incumbent local exchange  
10 company. And consistent with that order, at the end of the  
11 third paragraph on Page 3, we would like to add the following  
12 sentence: Accordingly, due to the urgency of this situation,  
13 Adelphia should be ordered to provide a customer contact list  
14 including customer name, billing address, and telephone number  
15 by close of business September 10, 2002.

16 CHAIRMAN JABER: And would that be done subject to a  
17 protective order?

18 MS. PRUITT: Yes, ma'am.

19 CHAIRMAN JABER: Mr. Rehwinkel, is that a condition  
20 that you are willing to accept?

21 MR. REHWINKEL: Yes, Madam Chairman.

22 CHAIRMAN JABER: Commissioners, do you have questions  
23 or a motion?

24 COMMISSIONER DEASON: I would move staff's  
25 recommendation as modified.

1 COMMISSIONER PALECKI: Second.

2 CHAIRMAN JABER: There has been a motion and a second  
3 to accept staff's recommendation as modified. All those in  
4 favor say aye.

5 (Simultaneous affirmative vote.)

6 CHAIRMAN JABER: Item 2 is approved.

7 MR. REHWINKEL: Thank you.

8 MS. PRUITT: Thank you, Commissioners.

9 CHAIRMAN JABER: Thank you.

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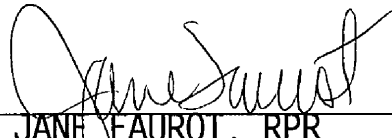
