address. list of the customers who have not made a choice of an 1 2 alternate provider. Otherwise, we won't be able to send the 3 notices to the customers of this action. 4 CHAIRMAN JABER: Commission Staff, we have done that 5 before? 6 MS. PRUITT: Yes, we have, Commissioners, in the 7 Verizon case. On Page 3 of staff's recommendation in the third 8 paragraph we mention an order in which we did order a LEC to 9 provide the information to the incumbent local exchange 10 company. And consistent with that order, at the end of the 11 third paragraph on Page 3, we would like to add the following 12 sentence: Accordingly, due to the urgency of this situation, 13 Adelphia should be ordered to provide a customer contact list 14 including customer name, billing address, and telephone number 15 by close of business September 10, 2002. 16 CHAIRMAN JABER: And would that be done subject to a 17 protective order? 18 MS.
