PUBLIC COUNSEL'S REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT

The Citizens of the State of Florida, through the Office of Public Counsel, pursuant to Rule 25-22.058, Florida Administrative Code, request that the Florida Public Service Commission permit oral argument on PUBLIC COUNSEL'S MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS AND MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF ORDER NO. PSC-02-1199-PAA-EI filed this date, and as grounds therefore, state:

1. This docket is at a cross-roads. Pursuant to the Commission's Order No. PSC-02-1199-PAA-EI, parties are preparing for hearing on the market monitoring issues. The order further provides that matters raised in protest of the proposed-agency-action portions of the order will also be considered at the market-monitoring hearing. And the order requires the GridFlorida Companies to file a rate structure proposal that allows the Commission to retain jurisdiction over the total cost of transmission service to retail customers. Implicitly, the Commission's approval of the GridFlorida ISO, and the relevance of going forward in the docket, is contingent upon the companies' ability to fashion a methodology for retention of the Commission's statutory jurisdiction. Oral argument would facilitate understanding of the intersection of these disparate matters and their effects upon the Commission's ability to proceed in the docket.

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2. As things now stand, native load retail customers enjoy a priority of transmission service from their vertically integrated utility under the Commission's regulatory oversight. The customers' rates for transmission as well as all other aspects of retail service are established by the Commission. And the Grid Bill places ultimate responsibility for the planning, development, and maintenance of the state-wide transmission grid under the Commission's jurisdiction. All that can change with approval of the GridFlorida ISO. Oral argument would greatly facilitate the Commission's understanding of the interplay of these activities today and the drastic effects its actions could have on the way things are done in the future.
