On June 25, 2002, Qwest Communications International, Inc. filed a petition for approval of its proposed settlement agreement with the Department of Legal Affairs, Office of the Attorney General of the State of Florida (OAG). Qwest Communications International, Inc. requested that the Commission find that its settlement agreement, once executed, was satisfying and dispositive of any claims of unauthorized transfers occurring during the period covered by the OAG's investigation over which the Commission would have overlapping jurisdiction. By Order No. PSC-02-1112-CO-TI, issued August 14, 2002, consummating PAA Order No. PSC-02-0998-PAA-TI, the Commission granted Qwest Communications International, Inc.'s petition and ordered that the docket be closed upon staff's verification of the execution of the settlement agreement between Qwest Communications International, Inc. and the OAG. Staff has verified that the settlement agreement was executed on September 18, 2002. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
