We are requesting cancellation of the certificate noted above. The company has been out of business for over a year. At the present time there does not appear to be any assets available to pay any fees or penalties that may still be due on this account.

On July 27, 2001, Orlando, Mauricio and Enrique Puche (3 of the 4 owners of GTI) were convicted of conspiracy to launder drug money in U.S. District Court and immediately imprisoned. Due to these circumstances it has been very difficult for us to complete an orderly end to the company's affairs.
