Staff respectfully requests your permission to make an oral modification to Item No. 14 at the October 15, 2002 Agenda Conference. The requested change is to the recommendation statement to Issue 10 and is as follows:

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, repression adjustments of 4,861 kgal to the water system and 3,889 kgal to the wastewater system are appropriate in this case. In order to monitor the effects of both the change in rate structure and the recommended revenue increase change, the utility should be ordered to prepare monthly reports detailing the number of bills rendered, the consumption billed, and the revenue billed. These reports should be provided, by customer class and meter size, on a quarterly basis for a period of two years, beginning with the first billing period after the increased approved rates go into effect.
