

FIPUG'S PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Pursuant to the Case Assignment and Scheduling Record (CASR) in this docket, the Florida Industrial Power Users Group (FIPUG) files its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions. FIPUG reserves the right to amend this preliminary statement.

PRELIMINARY ISSUES

1. **ISSUE:** What are the appropriate projected environmental cost recovery amounts for the period January 2003 through December 2003?
FIPUG: FIPUG has no position at this time, but reserves the right to take a position on this issue by the date of the prehearing conference.
2. **ISSUE:** What should be the effective date of the environmental cost recovery factors for billing purposes?
FIPUG: The factor should be effective beginning with the specified environmental cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2003 through December 2003. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2003 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2003, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.
3. **ISSUE:** What are the appropriate environmental cost recovery factors for the period January 2003 through December 2003 for each rate group?
FIPUG: FIPUG has no position at this time, but reserves the right to take a position on this issue by the date of the prehearing conference.

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
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
