This is in response to order No. PSC-02-1390-PAA-TX issued on October 8, 2002, in Docket No. 020620-TX. Please consider this a protest and/or an offer of settlement to resolve this docket.

Direct2Internet Corp. is not active at this time although the company does wish to keep its certificate active. We had requested that the company's mail be forwarded to our CPA firm, Feldman & Feldman, but apparently, it has not worked out as well as we had hoped. Based on this, on September 23, 2002, the company asked Paula Isler to change our mailing address to that of Feldman & Feldman. The company is now aware that the Regulatory Assessment Fee is due by January 30th of every year and with Feldman & Feldman receiving our mail directly, that should avoid this problem in the future. The 2001 Regulatory Assessment Fee, including penalty and interest charges, was mailed on October 1, 2002.

Direct2Internet Corp. agrees to waive any objection to the administrative cancellation of its certificate should it fail to pay in accordance with its settlement offer. If, however, there is a factual dispute as to the manner or level of compliance with any provision in the settlement, it is our understanding that Commission staff will bring the matter to the Commission for consideration.

The company respectively requests that the Commission accept its proposal to pay \$100 settlement instead of the \$500 penalty imposed. I understand that if the Commission approves this settlement, the \$100 settlement must be paid within 14 calendar days from the date of issuance of the Order accepting the settlement.
