FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION FOR CERTAIN INFORMATION RESPONSIVE TO CPV GULFCOAST, LTD.'S THIRD SET OF INTERROGATORIES

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to CPV Gulfcoast, Ltd.'s (CPV Gulfcoast's) Third Set of Interrogatories (the "Confidential Information"). In support thereof, FPL states:

Justification for Confidential Classification

The Confidential Information is contained in information that FPL provided to CPV Gulfcoast, the intervenors that have signed the confidentiality agreement, and Staff in FPL's Supplemental Response to CPV Gulfcoast's Third Set of Interrogatories, Interrogatory No. 82. FPL filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of this same material on September 30, 2002. The Confidential Information for which FPL seeks confidential classification consists of the actual and forecasted total installed costs for the Martin Peaker, Fort Myers Repowering, and Sanford Unit 5 Repowering projects.

The Confidential Information contains proprietary confidential business information relating to FPL's competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair FPL's competitive interests. These contractual pricing terms are intended to be and have been treated by FPL as private and confidential and have not been publicly disclosed, except for a single inadvertent disclosure of this information to the intervenors to these proceedings without properly identifying the information as confidential. Upon learning of this inadvertent disclosure, FPL immediately requested that each party to these dockets replace the original answer to Interrogatory No. 82 with the supplemental answer to Interrogatory No. 82, which properly identifies the information as "Confidential," and return the original answer to undersigned counsel.

Disclosing this information would significantly impair the competitive business interests of FPL by allowing FPL's competitors to understand specific asset values and unfairly compete against FPL. Thus, disclosure of the Confidential Information would injure FPL and FPL's customers.

An unredacted copy of the confidential documents, with all Confidential Information highlighted is attached as Exhibit A in an envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL." Exhibit B consists of two copies of the same material with all Confidential Information redacted. Exhibit C is a field-by-field justification of the confidential status of the Confidential Information.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests that the Commission grant the Confidential Information identified in Exhibits A and B confidential classification and exempt it from public disclosure.
