C. BASIC POSITION

FPU has properly projected its true-up amounts and projected gas costs. Its costs and projections are reasonable and its purchased gas cost recovery factors should be approved by the Commission.

D. STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Issue 1: **What is the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January, 2001 through December, 2001?**

FPU's Position: \$1,467,999 (overrecovery)

Issue 2: **What is the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January, 2002 through December, 2002?**

FPU's Position: \$1,234,930 (underrecovery)

Issue 3: **What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be refunded or collected in the January, 2003 through December, 2003 period?**

FPU's Position: \$233,069 (overrecovery)

Issue 4: **What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factor to be charged during the period January, 2003 through December, 2003?**


FPU's Position: 82.860 cents per therm.

Issue 5: **What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?**

FPU's Position: The factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after January, 2003, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for the period January, 2003 through December, 2003.

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
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
