The Commission should grant a waiver of Rule 25-6.015(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, as it relates to the storage media utilized to preserve records. The requested waiver will serve the purpose of the underlying statutes, and Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) will experience substantial hardship if its request is denied. The utility should also be required to petition for a new rule waiver if it changes the vendor or method used to copy its source
