This is in response to Order No. PSC -02-1487-PAA-TI in Docket No. 020690-TI issued on October 31<sup>st</sup> 2002. Please consider this an offer of settlement to resolve this docket.

Long Distance America, Inc. wishes to keep its certificate active. We have remitted the Regulatory Assessment Fee return; along with full payment of the 1999 fee on October 15<sup>th</sup> 2002 check number 1346. We are now aware that the Regulatory Assessment Fee return forms are mailed by the Commission in mid-December and that the return form and payment are due by January 30<sup>th</sup> of every year.

We have taken steps to comply with the Commission rules by retaining the following Law Firm who will now be maintaining our Certifications and regulatory compliance.

The company respectfully requests that the Commission accept its proposal to pay a \$500.00 settlement instead of the \$1,000 penalty imposed. I understand that if the Commission approves the settlement, the \$500.00 settlement must be paid within 14 calendar days from the date of issuance of the Order accepting the settlement.
