CITIZENS' MOTION TO REQUIRE RESPONSE BY FWSC TO CITIZENS' FIRST SET OF REQUESTS FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS BY NO LATER THAN MONDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2002

The Citizens of Florida (Citizens), by and through Jack Shreve, Public Counsel, request the Prehearing Officer to issue an order requiring Florida Water Services Corporation (FWSC) to respond to Citizens' first set of requests for production of documents by no later than Monday, November 18, 2002, and in support of this motion state the following:

- 1. The Florida Public Service Commission opened this docket on October 22, 2002, to investigate the proposed sale of FWSC to a newly created entity named Florida Water Services Authority (FWSA). Terms of the purchase agreement between FWSC and FWSA call for a closing by December 15, 2002, subject to FWSA being able to issue bonds for the purchase price and other conditions.
- 2. The short time frame before the anticipated closing of the transaction between FWSC and FWSA leaves little time to gather information regarding the proposed sale.
