PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF NEW ACCOUNT AND TREATMENT OF COSTS

COMES NOW, Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPU") through its undersigned and submits this Petition to establish an additional account and to amortize costs associated with right-of-way expenses and as basis states:

1. The name and address of Petitioner is:

- 3. FPU provides natural gas service in several areas of the state including portions of Palm Beach County. Within Palm Beach County, FPU has property in Lantana which is accessible by a crossing over tracks belonging to the Florida East Coast Railway Company ("FEC").
- 4. The maintenance of crossings such as this one is performed by the railroad on a periodic basis but the costs for such maintenance are billed to FPUC. The FEC has advised FPU that

the average life cycle for a mainline crossing such as this one is approximately six (6) years thus maintenance can be expected to occur on that cycle. Once the maintenance is performed the costs would be billed to FPUC. The most recent maintenance on this crossing was in 2002 and FPUC was billed \$40,509.00 for the work.

- 5. Access to the property in Lantana is necessary as part of the regulated operations of FPU and the crossing maintenance is necessary to maintain that access. Since these costs are related to the provision of regulated operations they should be included in the regulated accounts; however, since the useful life of the right-of-way access is six (6) years, it would be appropriate to capitalize the costs associated with the maintenance and amortize those costs over the expected useful life rather than to record the costs in a single year. This treatment of the costs would be more representative of annual costs than it would be to record the costs in a single year.
- 6. In order to report and account for these costs, FPU proposes to establish a new account in the general ledger to be Account No. 389.1, Rights-of-Way. The costs associated with the right-of-way maintenance will be capitalized and amortized over six (6) years and recorded in this new account.
- 7. FPU believes that the treatment proposed for the right-of-way maintenance costs charged by FEC to FPUC and the corresponding establishment of a new account are reasonable and would be consistent with the rules and policies of this Commission. The treatment would also be of benefit to the customers and should be approved by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons cited, FPU requests the Commission approve the proposed capitalization and amortization of right-of-way maintenance costs and the establishment of a new account for recording these costs.
