RE: Docket No. 021058-WS - Disposition of delinquent regulatory assessment fees and penalties for DeBary Associates, Inc., Econ Utilities Corporation, and Sandalhaven Utility, Inc.

ISSUE 1: Should the utilities identified in the analysis portion of staff's December 5, 2002 memorandum be ordered to show cause, in writing, within 21 days, why they should not remit RAFs, statutory penalties, and interest in their respective amounts for their apparent violation of Sections 350.113 and 367.145, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.120, Florida Administrative Code, for failure to timely pay regulatory assessment fees (RAFs)?

RECOMMENDATION: No. Show cause proceedings should not be initiated. Staff further recommends that the Commission refer the utilities' unpaid RAFs and associated penalties and interest to the State Comptroller's Office, Department of Banking and Finance, for permission to write off the accounts as uncollectible, in the amounts identified in the analysis portion of staff's December 5, 2002 memorandum.
