ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: No. If no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of the issuance date of the Order, the Order will become final upon the issuance of a Consummating Order. Staff recommends that if a protest is filed, then resolution of the protest should be addressed during the six-month review process. Thereafter, this docket should remain open pending until: 1) completion of the development of a Sprint-Florida Performance Measurements plan; 2) full implementation of the Sprint OSS Performance Measurements; 3) Sprint measurement reporting systems for ALECs are completely and accurately operational; 4) six-month reviews of performance measurements have begun; and 5) the completion of the initial third-party audit.
