**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on December 11, 2002, Herbert C. Broadfoot II (the "Trustee"), the Chapter 7 Trustee of the bankruptcy estate (the "Estate") of CRG International, Inc. d/b/a Network One (referred to herein as "Network One") has filed "Trustee's Motion to Approve Compromise With Norcom, Inc. 



COLLECTION AGREEMENT AND GRANT SETTLEMENT AUTHORITY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all parties in interest that on August 23, 2002, Trustee filed Trustee's Motion to Approve Collection Agreement and Grant Settlement Authority. Trustee has entered into a collection agreement (the "Collection Agreement") with RecoverDebt, Inc. ("RecoverDebt") providing for collection of Debtor's accounts receivable. U.S. Bank holds a first priority security interest in Debtor's accounts receivable. The collection agreement with RecoverDebt provides in paragraph 6 that the Trustee authorized RecoverDebt to settle certain types of accounts under certain specified conditions without further authorization or consent of the Trustee and provides that the Trustee may orally authorize RecoverDebt to accept less than the amount assigned on any account. Trustee seeks approval of the Collection Agreement and, specifically, approval of the settlement authority described in Paragraph 6 of the Collection Agreement. Said motion, which includes a copy of


