Such confidential and proprietary business information may include, but is not limited to, information in written, oral or other tangible or intangible form, including information obtained during observation, that depicts, reflects, or constitutes the type, quantity, location and use or non-use of telecommunications equipment or facilities that Verizon or any other entity has placed on Verizon's property, or information concerning the number, identity or location of customers that Verizon or any other entity serves or anticipates serving from said



telecommunications equipment or facilities. Such information affects Verizon's or its customers' competitive interests, the disclosure of which could impair their competitive business interests.

This Notice exempts this material from §119.07(1) of the Florida Statutes and §24(a), Art. 1 of the State Constitution and protects it from public disclosure. The claimed confidential information falls within Florida Statutes § 364.183(3)(e), which defines the term "proprietary confidential business information" to include "information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of that information." Verizon will file a request for permanent confidential classification at the appropriate time, in accordance with Commission Rules.


