By letter dated October 29, 2002, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated filed a request for approval of interconnection, unbunding, resale, and collocation agreement between Sprint-Florida, Incorporated and ICG Telecom Group, Inc. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was January 27, 2003.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on January 16, 2002. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.17 of the Administrative Procedures Manual.
