The first four, 10423-01, 13610-01, 14453-01, and 04004-02 should have been followed up with formal requests in a timely manner. They were not and as such these documents may now be made public. 06983-02 can also be made public as no request followed the notice of intent. 24707-02 and 08110-02 are still confidential. Even though there has been no ruling on these, they maintain there confidentiality through the appeal at which time they are to be returned to BellSouth.

- 04004-02 - Supra's motion for reconsideration and clarification of Order PSC-02-0413-FOF-TP.

The 4 documents above, all filed by Supra, were submitted with claims. Should they have been followed up with formal requests for confidentiality? Should requests be filed now and ruled on before we ship the documents to court?
