Dear Mr. Winrow:

We received Mr. John Guastella's January 31, 2003, letter requesting that staff reconsider its January 9, 2003 recommendation regarding the proposed rate increase. In order to consider the items identified by Mr. Guastella and to analyze the new information, we will need the following documentation by March 7, 2003.

1. Records supporting \$213,400 in CIAC as described in Mr. Guastella's letter on page 2;
2. Documentation of plant additions of \$36,959 in Account No. 354, T&D Structures, made in 1983;
3. Documentation of plant additions of \$15,840 in Account No. 380, Treatment & Disposal Equipment, made in 1983;
4. Provide a copy of the bills and invoices supporting the \$6,000 in rate case expense referred to in Mr. Guastella's letter on page 3; this documentation should include a cost breakdown of hours and hourly rate as well as a description of the type of service provided for each person/firm providing service; this documentation should also include an estimate of the expense needed to complete the case through the agenda;
5. A description of the mechanism (earmarking revenue for specific uses and/or escrow accounts, and a funding plan) referred to in Mr. Guastella's letter on page 3;


