The Florida Public Service Commission will conduct an Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Clause audit to determine actual sales and total conservation costs and revenues for the period January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, in accordance with Commission audit procedures. Access will be requested to documents and records of the utility and, if necessary, supporting records for affiliate company transactions that affectregulated operations. Staff auditors may also request to review the utility's external auditworking papers for the most recent independent audit. The Audit Access to Records rule for each industry states:

If agreement cannot be reached, the utility shall discuss the issue with successive levels of supervisors at the Commission until an agreement is reached.
