COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and files its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order No. PSC-01-1877-CFO-TL Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

- On August 24, 2001, the Commission issued an Order granting
 Bellsouth's Requests for Confidential Treatment of Documents Nos. 06367-00,
 07636-01 and Cross Referenced Documents Nos. 06766-01 and 07497-01.
- 2. The reasons BellSouth asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original Requests for Confidential Treatment continue to pertain.
