1. Please explain why wastewater gallons treated in June 2001 exceeded water gallons sold in that same month.
2. Explain why May and June 2001 had the highest level of wastewater gallons treated during the test year, which was during the non-peak summer season.
3. Explain if there any relationship to the June 2001 peak wastewater treatment level and the large amount of unaccounted for water in that same month?
4. State whether the utility has any users of water or wastewater service that are not charged for service. If yes, provide a detailed list of each user, why each user is not billed, any measured consumption (estimated if not known), and what type of meter these customers have or should have, all of which can be used to estimate billing determinants and revenues.
5. If the clubhouse drains its pool, does the water flow onto the ground or does it go through the wastewater system? If it is drained through the wastewater system, how is this measured or estimated.
