Outlined below in accordance with the Commission staff's February 13, 2003 letter, are our responses to the issues raised therein. I have also attached various documents in order to comply with those requests. For ease of interpretation, I have restated the issues or questions raised by the staff before each response.

1. Notice to governments and utilities. Exhibit I to the application contained the affidavit of notice to governments and utilities in Volusia, Seminole, and Brevard Counties pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(5), Florida Administrative Code. However, the affidavit was not accompanied by a copy of the notice given. Subsequent to the filing of the application, an affidavit of an amended notice to governments and utilities was filed on January 24, 2003. While that affidavit was accompanied by a copy of the amended notice, it was not accompanied by a list of entities in Volusia, Seminole, and Brevard Counties. Instead, it was accompanied by a list of entities in Orange County which the affidavit indicated was not going to be noticed.

Please file a revised affidavit for Exhibit I which is accompanied by both a copy of the amended notice and a list of all entities receiving the amended notice.

Response - Attached hereto is revised Exhibit "I" which includes an affidavit, a copy of the notice, and a list of those persons noticed under the provisions of Rule 25-30.030(5), Florida Administrative Code.

2. **Notice to Customers.** Exhibit K to the application contained the affidavit of the notice to customers and property owners pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(6), Florida Administrative Code. Subsequent to the filing of the application, an affidavit of an amended notice to customers and property owners was filed on January 24, 2003. Neither affidavit was accompanied by a copy of the notice nor a list of the customers and property owners receiving the notice.

Please file a revised affidavit for Exhibit K which is accompanied by both a copy of the amended notice and a list of entities receiving the notice.

Response - Attached is a copy of a revised Exhibit K, including an affidavit of noticing, a list of the property owners noticed and a copy of the notice sent to those property owners as per your request.

3. **Newspaper Publication.** Exhibit J to the application was to be a late-filed affidavit of the newspaper publication of the notice pursuant to Rule 25-30.030(7), Florida Administrative Code. While it is staff's understanding the notice was placed in separate newspapers for the respective counties, the Commission has not received the late-filed affidavits of the newspaper publications.

Please file the late-filed Exhibit J which includes affidavits from the newspapers in which the notice was published.

Response - Attached hereto as Late-Filed Exhibit "J" are the affidavits from the newspapers for the three counties noticed (Brevard, Volusia and Seminole), including a copy of the notice.

In addition, the legal description and representation of the territory proposed to be served by Farmton in Exhibits A, F, G, and H of the application are inconsistent. These inconsistencies will need to be resolved in order for staff to complete its evaluation of the utility's application. Specifically, the legal description of the proposed territory and the territory map must match exactly with respect to any excluded areas and to any portions of sections not included.

Response - Exhibit "A" included a legal description as Attachment "A" thereto. While that legal description is intended to describe the outer boundaries of the proposed territory, it includes references to plats and other recorded documents and as such, does not comply with the rule. This is the reason why Exhibit "H" was supplied in order to be an accurate description of the proposed territory in accordance with the rule. Exhibit "H" should be utilized for all purposes in order to comply

with the rule and statute, and has been utilized for noticing.

However, by this letter we are hereby requesting a restrictive amendment to the territory outlined in our original application (Exhibit "H" and "G"). Specifically, Exhibit "H" did not describe any of the out parcels within the proposed territory that are not proposed for service. We have prepared a revised Exhibit "H" which we have attached seven copies of to this letter, which should replace that previously filed with the Commission. This description includes the same outer boundary description as the original Exhibit "H," but also excludes the out parcels which are shown on the new map included as revised Exhibit "G." I am also attaching seven copies of revised Exhibit "G," the map of the territory, which correctly corresponds in all respects with the description outlined in revised Exhibit "H."


I am also attaching two copies of the revised Exhibit "F" (tariffs) to reflect this restrictive amendment and the lesser territory as described in Exhibit "H."

We have attempted to correct the errors in the indices of the tariff as well, and exclude or note the inapplicable provisions of the tariff for Farmton.

We are currently working on the proposed service availability charges and policy for inclusion in the revised tariff and will submit those in the near future.
