Dear Jacque Wood:

Jackie Knight forwarded your e-mail to me. It appears your e-mail responded to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations', Uniform Business Report, which is a different state agency, and the Florida Public Service Commission's 2/19/03 delinquent notice for nonpayment of the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee.

This Commission granted Toll Call, Inc. its payphone certificate effective 12/28/01 and it remains active today. The Regulatory Assessment Fee is applicable if a certificate is active during any portion of a calendar year, and a certificate remains active until a company requests cancellation of the certificate in writing and complies with Rule 25-24.514(2)(a) and (b), F.A.C. or the Commission cancels a company's certificate on its own motion for a rule or order violation. It should be noted that if a certificate is cancelled on the Commission's own motion, any unpaid Regulatory Assessment Fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, will be turned over to collections.

This means that if you wish to cancel Toll Call, Inc.'s certificate voluntarily, the company must pay the 2002 fee, including penalty and interest (\$56.00) plus the 2003 fee (\$50.00), for a total of \$106.00. Our records show that you returned the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee return notice on January 22, 2003, showing zero revenues and zero payphones in operation at the end of 2002. However, payment for the minimum fee was not included. The Regulatory Assessment Fee return form states under Line 8, "As provided in Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, the minimum annual fee is \$50" and "This form must be completed and returned regardless of the amount of revenues reported."

Please let me know by March 19, 2003, how you wish to proceed and if you need the 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form, a copy of the cancellation rule, or any other information. Thanks.

This e-mail is in response to the above letter we received concerning the 2003 filing of the Uniform Business Report. As I read thru the frequently asked questions on filing this report - question 4 stated that if we did not respond the result would be the dissolution or revocation of the corporation and we would no longer be recognized as active. We no longer have an interest in being registered as a foreign corporation in the State of Florida since we are now out of the telecommunications business and have directed our business path elsewhere. I assumed by not filing this would automatically revoke our activity in Florida. I apologize if this was the wrong assumption and we were suppose to do something else. I had already notified the Sales & Use Tax Dept. that we were making our final filing as of December 31, 2002.

Please accept this e-mail as our notification of same - we no longer wish to be active in the State of Florida and will not proceed with any further filings for same.
