In accordance with the expedited process established in order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL), Verizon Florida Inc. (Verizon) requests the Florida Public Service Commission to direct the Pooling Administrator (PA) to provide Verizon with a new prefix of telephone numbers in a block for in St. Petersburg, Florida.
Verizon considers the highlighted information in this letter to be confidential because it contains the customer's name and the customer's planned use of the requested numbers. Verizon is obligated to protect the identity of the customer and competitors could use this information to gain an unfair competitive advantage. Therefore, this filing is made under a Claim of Confidentiality pursuant to F.S. 364.183(1) and Rule 25-22.006(5). Verizon understands the highlighted information must be kept confidential until returned to Verizon. telephone numbers for their new national headquarters. This specific request of numbers will allow to unify the numbers that they now have spread across several exchanges and better support their business needs.

Guidelines and completed the necessary Months to Exhaust Certification, which is included as Attachment B.

Verizon submitted the request for a new block because Verizon does not have _____ sequential numbers available within the Gandy central office to meet _____ needs. Although the Gandy office is in the multi-switch rate center of St Petersburg, Verizon does not have available numbers in its existing inventory from another switch within the rate center to satisfy the request.

On or about March 10, 2003, the PA, via the Pooling Administration System (PAS), denied the request on the grounds that Verizon had not met the rate center-based months-to-exhaust criteria set forth in the Thousands – Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines, notwithstanding the fact that Verizon does not have the numbering resources needed to satisfy its customer's demand in the switch at issue. This decision, provided by the PAS system, is included as Attachment C.

Under earlier months-to-exhaust procedures, waivers or exceptions were granted where customer hardships were demonstrated or where the service provider's inventory did not have a block of numbers large enough to meet a customer's specific request. Under existing procedures, the PA looks at the number of months to exhaust for the entire rate center without any exceptions. However, paragraph 64 of the FCC's Third Report and Order in the Numbering Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier "... should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request." Also, paragraph 64 indicates that "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e. vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." The Florida Commission thus has the authority to review the PA's decisions and reverse them when appropriate.

Verizon seeks the Commission's review of the PA's decision to withhold numbering resources. The PA's decision violates the intent and requirements of the FCC in allowing carriers access to numbering resources to meet specific customer demands upon a sufficient showing of need, and the PA's denial of numbering resources interferes with Verizon's ability to serve this customer.

Verizon requests that the Commission instruct the PA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of ______. Please do not hesitate to call me if you have any questions.


