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

SUBJECT MATTER FOR FPL CORPORATE REPRESENTATIVE DEPOSITION

1. All routes considered by FPL for a transmission line connecting FPL's Collier Substation with FPL's Orange River Substation.
2. All segments or sections of all routes considered by FPL for a transmission line connecting FPL's Collier Substation with FPL's Orange River Substation.
3. The costs of all routes considered by FPL for a transmission line connecting FPL's Collier Substation with FPL's Orange River Substation.
4. The costs of all segments or sections of all routes considered by FPL for a transmission line connecting FPL's Collier Substation with FPL's Orange River Substation.
5. All variations and combinations of routes and segments or sections considered by FPL for a transmission line connecting FPL's Collier Substation with FPL's Orange River Substation.
6. The costs of all variations and combinations of routes and route segments or sections considered by FPL for a transmission line connecting FPL's Collier Substation with FPL's Orange River Substation.
7. A description of the decision making process employed by FPL in arriving at the identification of its proposed route, i.e., the specific Collier-Orange River #3 Project for which FPL has petitioned the Commission for a determination of need in this proceeding, including, without limitation:
 - a. All aspects of the decision-making process by which FPL considered the specific project route and all alternative routes and route segments to the specific project proposed by FPL in this proceeding;
 - b. The exact identification of who, whether an individual or a group of individuals, made the decision to select the specific route for the project proposed

by FPL in this proceeding; and

c. Exactly when the decision was made regarding FPL's selection of the specific project route and corridor that is the subject of this docket.

8. Exactly why and how FPL selected the specific proposed route for the proposed Collier-Orange River #3 Project.
9. The extent of public input, and the consideration that FPL gave to such public input, with regard to all alternative routes and route segments that were considered by FPL or proposed or suggested by members of the public or other interested parties, including any participants in the "community advisory panel" meetings that FPL held in connection with the proposed project.
10. How FPL evaluates terrorist/sabotage issues with respect to FPL's transmission and generation system, including specifically how terrorist/sabotage and other catastrophic risk issues are incorporated into FPL's decision-making regarding the siting of transmission lines and power plants.
11. How FPL evaluates issues relating to potential accidents and other catastrophic risks, and the probability of accidents and other catastrophic risks, with respect to FPL's transmission and generation system, including specifically how such accident-related issues are incorporated into FPL's decision-making regarding the siting of transmission lines and power plants.
12. Load forecasts used in FPL's decision processes that led to the decision to apply for the PSC's determination of need for the proposed Collier-Orange River #3 Project.
