Dear Madam Secretary:

Bell Atlantic Communications, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Long Distance ("Verizon LD") hereby requests authority to discontinue its domestic casual calling service(s) from domestic locations; where network facilities and billing systems permit. Verizon LD is a non-dominant provider of casual calling services. Pursuant to Section 63.71(b)(1) through (5) (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(1) through (5)), Verizon LD provides the following information:

1. Name and Address - Bell Atlantic Communications, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Long Distance, 1320 N. Court House Rd., 9th Floor, Arlington, VA 22201.
2. Date of planned service discontinuance – Verizon LD plans to discontinue its casual calling services on April 1, 2003.
3. Points of geographic areas of service affected – Throughout the states of Connecticut, Delaware, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Virginia and Vermont.
4. Brief description of type of service affected – Wherever billing systems permit, the Company will cease to provide domestic casual calling service, a service whereby the Customer accesses the Company's service by dialing the access code assigned to the Company prior to dialing the destination number (e.g., 1016963+1+area code +destination number). Verizon LD has never marketed


casual calling services in the past and has no plans to market such services in the future. Verizon LD will, however, continue to provide other interexchange services (including but not limited to presubscribed dial 1, calling card, operator services and Directory Assistance calling) throughout its service territory. The Company is not seeking to forfeit any state authorization (or certification) in connection with this application. It seeks only to discontinue the offering of casual calling services.

Once its application to discontinue casual calling services is effective, Verizon LD will post revisions to Terms and Conditions on its website to note that casual calling service will be blocked wherever network systems permit. This service will also be blocked in Maryland, West Virginia and the District of Columbia at the time the authority to offer long distance services in those jurisdictions is granted.

Verizon LD has notified all customers with casual calling usage in the February and March billing cycles of its intent to discontinue casual calling services. Verizon LD notified these customers via a bill message.

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
