JOINT MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE


The Florida Competitive Carriers Association (FCCA), AT&T Communications of the Southern States, LLC (AT&T), MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLP (collectively, WorldCom), ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. (ITC^DeltaCom), Access Integrated Networks, Inc. (AIN) and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) (collectively, Joint Movants) move this Commission for an order continuing the hearing currently scheduled for April 22, 2003. As grounds therefore, Joint Movants state:

1. Today Joint Movants have filed a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement. If approved by the Commission, the Settlement Agreement will resolve the outstanding discovery dispute between the FCCA and BellSouth.

2. The Settlement Agreement provides, in part, that certain parties will be substituted for the FCCA and that the hearing currently scheduled for April 22, 2003 will be rescheduled at a time certain after receipt of discovery, but in no event later than June 30, 2003.

3. Joint Movants further request that they be consulted regarding the selection of a new hearing date so as to avoid any potential conflicts with the Memorial Day holiday and previously scheduled commitments...

THEREFORE, Joint Movants request that the April 22, 2003 hearing in this matter be continued and rescheduled, in accordance with the Joint Movants' Settlement Agreement.


