BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On March 17, 2003, BellSouth filed its response to Florida Public Commission Staff's First Request for Production of Documents. BellSouth's Response to Staff's First Requests for Production of Documents, Request Nos. 2 and 7 contain information that is proprietary to BellSouth. BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification on that same day.
- 2. BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential
 Classification because the information contained in BellSouth's Response to Staff's First
 Request for Production of Documents, Request Nos. 2 and 7 include business plans,
 forecasts, contractual data and other confidential business practices/procedures utilized
 by BellSouth to conduct business. A more specific description of this information is
 contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would cause

competitive harm to BellSouth and provide competitors with an unfair advantage in future negotiations. The information discussed in Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information and customer proprietary information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

- 3. Attachment A to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.
- 4. Attachment B to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is redacted copies of the documents containing the confidential information.
- 5. Attachment C to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.
- 6. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable, BellSouth treats this information as confidential in all requests, and this information has not been generally disclosed.
- 7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.

Explanation of Proprietary Information

- 1. The subject information includes BellSouth's business plans, forecasts and other confidential business information of BellSouth. If this information were disclosed publicly, it would damage the competitive interests of BellSouth. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 364.183(3)(e).
- 2. The information contained concerns bidding information or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair BellSouth's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Accordingly, the subject information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Florida Statues Section 364.183(3)(d).
