RE: Docket No. 021249-TP – Complaint of Supra Telecommunications and Information System, Inc.’s Against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. For Non-Compliance With Commission Order No. PSC-02-0878-FOF-TP

Honorable Commissioner Bradley:

On December 18, 2002, Supra Telecommunications and Information Systems, Inc.’s (“Supra”) filed a Complaint against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (“BellSouth”) for Non-Compliance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0878-FOF-TP. In its Complaint, Supra alleged that BellSouth’s refusal to provide its FastAccess Internet Service (“FastAccess”) to customers who receive voice service from Supra was a violation of Commission Order No. PSC-02-0878-FOF-TP. Further, Supra asked this Commission for expedited relief in this matter.

On January 7, 2003, the last day it had in which to file a response, BellSouth filed a Motion to Dismiss and opposition to the request for the expedited relief. On March 20, 2003, Commission Staff filed a Recommendation in which the staff recommended denial of BellSouth’s Motion to Dismiss for the April 1, 2003, Commission Agenda Conference. After the close of business, on the eve of the Commission Agenda Conference, and after Supra’s counsel had made the trip from Miami to Tallahassee, Supra’s Regulatory Office was notified by the Commission’s General Counsel that this Complaint item would be deferred from the April 1, 2003, Agenda Conference. Until today, Supra has no understanding or explanation why this item was deferred from the April 1, 2003, Agenda Conference. Further, Supra has noticed that the hearing on BellSouth’s Motion to Dismiss (not a hearing on the substantive merits of Supra’s Petition) has been rescheduled for another 30 days, to the May 6, 2003, Agenda Conference.

Thus, Supra seeks an explanation as to why this item, seeking expedited relief resulting from BellSouth's outright refusal to comply with this Commission's Order, cannot get past the pleading stage for over 5 months. It is apparent that delay in this matter only serves to hurt consumers.
