Sprint's Request for Confidential Classification Pursuant to Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes

Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (hereinafter "Sprint") hereby requests that the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") classify certain documents and/or records identified herein as confidential, exempt from public disclosure under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes and issue any appropriate protective order reflecting such a decision. Sprint previously filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification on April 2, 2003 for this information and now files this Request for Confidential Classification pursuant to the requirements of Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. The information that is the subject of this request is vendor specific pricing information or information from which such information can be derived. The information has been filed, under seal, with the Division of Records and Reporting.



2. Two (2) unredacted copies of the documents are attached to this request. One unredacted (highlighted) copy has been submitted to the Division of Records and Reporting this same day. The confidential information is identified by yellow highlighting. (An unredacted copy was previously submitted to the Division of Records and Reporting accompanying Sprint's Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification filed on April 2, 2003. However, this copy did not highlight the specific information for which Sprint requests confidentiality.)
3. The information for which the Request is submitted is vendor specific pricing information, or information from which such information can be derived, and thus meets the definition of confidential proprietary business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(d), Florida Statutes. Specific justification for confidential treatment is set forth in Attachment A.
4. Section 364.183(3), F.S., provides:
 - (3) The term "proprietary confidential business information" means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. The term includes, but is not limited to:
 - (a) Trade Secrets.
 - (b) Internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors.
 - (c) Security measures, systems, or procedures.

- (d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the company or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.
 - (e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information.
 - (f) Employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities.
5. The subject information has not been publicly released. Furthermore, release of the information could impair the efforts of the company or its affiliates to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and could impair the competitive business interests of Sprint.
6. The commission has previously found information similar in character to be confidential. See, *In Re: Investigation into Pricing Unbundled Network Elements*, Docket No. 990649B-TP, Order No. PSC-02-0451-CFO-TP.

Based on the foregoing, Sprint respectfully requests that the Commission grant the Request for Confidential Classification, exempt the information from disclosure under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes and issue any appropriate protective order, protecting the information from disclosure while it is maintained at the Commission.

Page and line numbers of Attachment to Response to Staff's POD No. 21	Justification for Confidential Treatment
Page 1, highlighted portions of lines 7, 11, 15, 16, 18, 19	Contains Sprint-Florida vendor specific pricing information, or information from which such information can be derived, which Sprint-Florida is required by the terms of the vendor contracts to keep confidential. Allowing competitors access to this information would compromise Sprint-Florida's relationship with the vendors, would adversely impact Sprint-Florida's ability to contract on favorable terms and would unfairly advantage competitors by allowing them to develop marketing and pricing plans without incurring the time and expense that a competitor would otherwise have to expend.
Page 2, highlighted portions of lines 6, 7, 9, 11	Contains Sprint-Florida vendor specific pricing information, or information from which such information can be derived, which Sprint-Florida is required by the terms of the vendor contracts to keep confidential. Allowing competitors access to this information would compromise Sprint-Florida's relationship with the vendors, would adversely impact Sprint-Florida's ability to contract on favorable terms and would unfairly advantage competitors by allowing them to develop marketing and pricing plans without incurring the time and expense that a competitor would otherwise have to expend.
Page 3, highlighted portion of line 5	Contains Sprint-Florida vendor specific pricing information, or information from which such information can be derived, which Sprint-Florida is required by the terms of the vendor contracts to keep confidential. Allowing competitors access to this information would compromise Sprint-Florida's relationship with the vendors, would adversely impact Sprint-Florida's ability to contract on favorable terms and would unfairly advantage competitors by allowing them to develop marketing and pricing plans without incurring the time and expense that a competitor would otherwise have to expend.

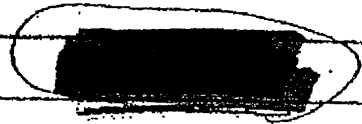

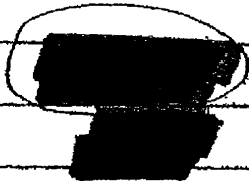
