> The current Utility has filed the appropriate reports through the first 4. quarter of 2003. Since new homes are being built constantly, thus adding new customers, it is difficult for the Utility to analyze the true effect of the conservation program and/or inclining block rate structure. However, comparing residential consumption bills for customers over 10,000 gallons per month as a percentage of the total residential customers for 2001 to present, it appears that there is approximately a 5% reduction in those customers. With regard to the expenditures made towards water conservation programs, the Utility has and will continue to expend those funds for that purpose. However, the Utility has had some difficulty obtaining approval from the Commission and/or St. Johns River Water Management District of its proposed "water conservation program" and the expenditures to be made as a part of that program. The Utility will continue to work to receive appropriate approval and is committed to expending the funds which it committed to spend pursuant to the referenced Order.
