

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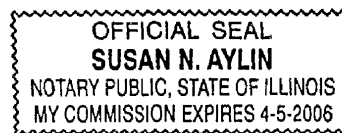

On April 15, 2003, the Florida Public Service Commission approved interim wastewater rates for Utilities, Inc. of Florida.
