In accordance with the Memorandum issued in this docket on May 27, 2003, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") respectfully submits the following list of proposed issues for consideration in this docket. The issues stated herein are preliminary in nature and are made consistent with the Commission's May 27, 2003 Memorandum. In the event that additional issues are identified or discussed during the meeting scheduled to occur on June 4, 2003, BellSouth reserves the right to supplement, revise, or modify this list. BellSouth's proposed issues are:

- 1. Should the Commission consider the complaint of MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC and MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. (collectively "MCI") as it relates to the MFS Agreement and the 1997 Agreement (as both Agreements are defined in the Complaint)?
 - A. Should the doctrine of laches bar any of MCI's claims relating to the MFS Agreement and/or the 1997 Agreement?
 - B. Should the doctrine of waiver bar any of MCI's claims relating to the MFS Agreement and/or the 1997 Agreement?
 - C. Should the doctrine of estoppel bar any of MCI's claims relating to the MFS Agreement and/or the 1997 Agreement?
- 2. Should the Commission bar or hold in abeyance any or all of MCI's claims due to its failure to exhaust the dispute resolution process set forth in the interconnection agreements?
- 3. Is MCI entitled to the benefit of TELRIC-based rates for that portion of facilities used to transport interstate and intrastate access traffic?

- 4. When an interconnection agreement does not include a rate for a particular service, have the parties reached agreement on the price for such service?
- 5. If the parties have not reached agreement on the price for a service, does the party requesting such a service order it from BellSouth's tariffs at the applicable tariff rates?
- 6. Do the terms, conditions, and prices of the interconnection agreements executed in 2001 (as defined in MCI's Complaint) apply retroactively from the expiration date of the 1997 Agreement (as defined in MCI's Complaint), June 19, 2000, forward?
- 7. Should MCI be required to submit requests for local services using the correct method for ordering such services; for example, by using a local service request ("LSR") when applicable?
