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COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Mr. Willis, I know that you don't need to make a -- well, just introduce yourself, too. MR. WILLIS: Marshall Willis on behalf of the Florida

Public Service Commission.

COMMISSIONER DEASON: Let me take this opportunity to welcome everyone to the hearing. The preliminary assessment is
