The Applicant and the City of Cape Coral, Florida ("City"), have agreed to enter into a written agreement pursuant to which, among other matters, the Applicant will provide bulk wastewater service to the City ("Agreement"), which the City will re-sell to the RealMark Group, which is developing in Section 21, Township 42 South, Range 24 East, in the City of Cape Coral, Lee County, Florida. A true an correct copy of the Agreement will be provided and attached to this Application as Exhibit "A".
- 4. The purpose of the Agreement is to provide wastewater service to this new development within the City. The City is currently unable to provide wastewater services to the development.
