
On April 25, 2003, at the audit exit conference for the "Audit of Transfer of Assets From Southern Union Gas to Florida Public Utilities Company as of the Transfer Date of December 14, 2001", the receiving company, Florida Public Utilities, indicated certain of staff's working papers should be held in a temporary confidential status in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

On May 1, 2003, staff filed the identified audit working papers with the Division of Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, document 03992-03.
