Pursuant to Order No. PSC-02-1168-PAA-WS, issued August 26, 2002, and consummated by Order No. PSC-02-1273-CO-WS, issued September 18, 2002, this docket was to remain open until staff verified "that the utility has: purchased insurance, posted telephone numbers as required, completed the pro forma improvements, and purchased the land on which its treatment systems are located or has entered into a long-term lease such as a 99-year lease. Upon verification of the above by our staff, the docket may be administratively closed."

Staff has now verified that the utility has accomplished all of the above requirements. Instead of purchasing the land, the utility has submitted proof of a recorded long-term lease. Therefore, this docket may now be administratively closed.
