Docket No. 021251-WU was opened to address the request by Mobile Manor, Inc. for acknowledgment of nonprofit exempt status. However, upon investigation into the matter, staff determined that Mobile Manor, Inc. does not qualify as a nonprofit entity at this time. As stated in the above-referenced letter, Mobile Manor, Inc. has subsequently withdrawn its request for nonprofit exemption acknowledgment. Staff has determined that there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission regarding Mobile Manor, Inc.'s filing, and no agency action has been taken. Accordingly, staff believes that it is appropriate to close this docket administratively.
